[Bellingham's Recovery Café](#) is part of the nationwide [Recovery Café Network](#), made up of 79 cafes across the U.S. Located at the First Baptist Church at 110 Flora St., is a drug- and alcohol-free space in downtown Bellingham for anyone in recovery or close to someone in recovery. Open on **Tuesdays and Wednesdays from noon to 4 p.m.**, the café offers a free meal and weekly small group check-ins. The café operates on a membership basis, where members commit to giving back to the café. Recovery Café will be OPEN on 12/25.
