#### WORKING FAMILIES TAX CREDIT

<u>The Working Families Tax Credit</u> is a tax credit for low to moderate income working adults and families. Credit amounts can be up to \$1290 depending on income and household size. Eligibility requirements:

- Lived in Washington a minimum of 183 days.
- Are at least 25 and under 65 years of age OR have a qualifying child in 2024.
- Filed a 2024 federal tax return with either a Social Security Number or an Individual Taxpayer Identification Number.
- Meet the income requirements (see table <u>here</u>).
