FERNDALE FOOD BANK

<u>Ferndale Food Bank</u> provides grocery distribution and home and drop site food delivery to all community members in need. Single individuals and families can visit once a week for as long as assistance is needed.

The food bank is open Mondays, Wednesdays, and Saturdays from 9:00 - 11:00am. First time visitors will fill out a new client form. From then on, only a check in slip with name and household size will be needed. New client forms can be filled out in advance.
