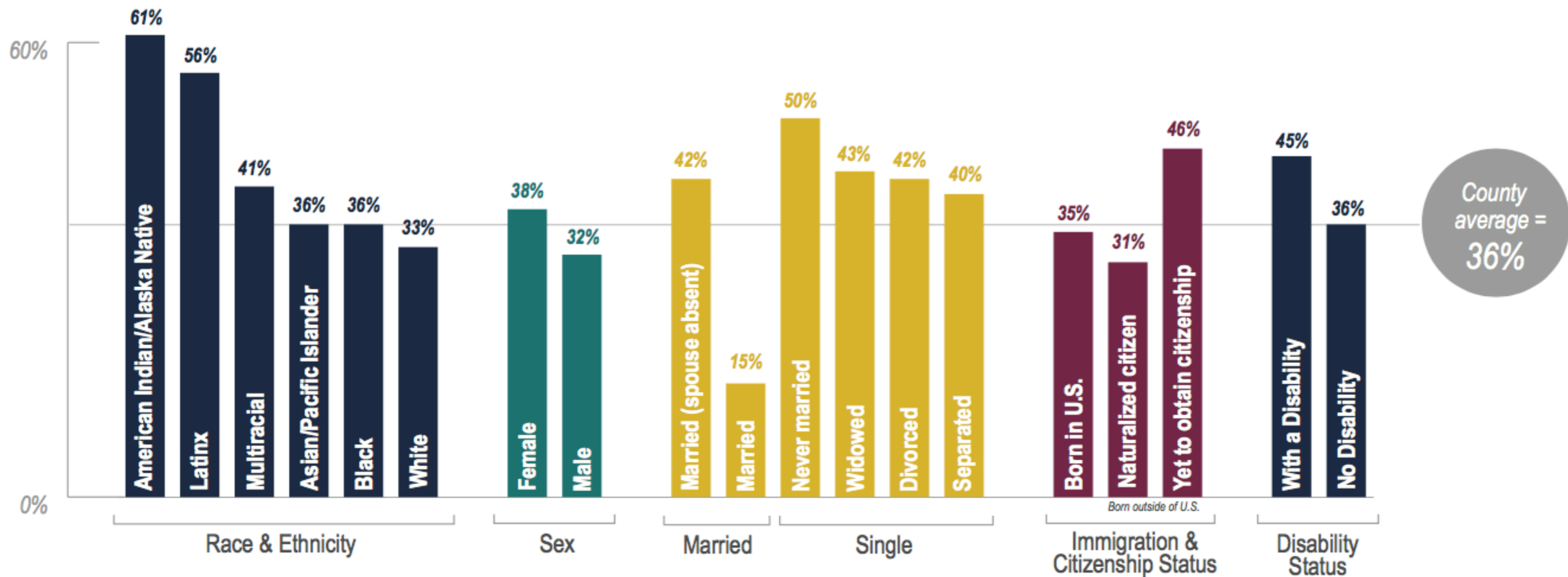


WHO IS MORE LIKELY TO EXPERIENCE POVERTY IN WHATCOM?

On average, 27 percent of people living in Washington are struggling to make ends meet. Whatcom's average is higher, and a person's likelihood of experiencing poverty is influenced by many factors, including race, sex, relationship status, citizenship, and disability status.
