School Meals:

Learn how to apply for Free and Reduced Meals in your school district.

Bellingham Public Schools

Pick up an application at your school's front office or apply online. Certain schools qualify for universal free meals and do not require an application: *Alderwood, Birchwood, Carl Cozier, Cordata, Happy Valley, Northern Heights, Roosevelt, and Sunnyland Elementary Schools; Fairhaven, Shuksan, and Whatcom Middle Schools; Options and Squalicum High Schools*

Blaine School District

Complete an online application through your Family Access account, or download an application and return it to your school office.

Ferndale School District

Complete an online application through your Skyward Family Access account, or download an application and return it to your school office.

Lummi Nation School

Applications can be obtained from and returned to any school office.

Lynden School District

Download an application and return it to your school office.

Meridian School District

Pick up an application at your school's front office or download an application online.

Nooksack Valley School District

School meals are free for all students for the 2023-2024 school year. Families do not need to fill out a meal application for their students to receive meals.
